Thank you for your participation in the Clean Vehicle Rebate Project (CVRP) implemented by the California Air Resources Board pursuant to Assembly Bill 118 and the Air Quality Improvement Program. As you know, CVRP offsets a portion of the incremental cost of advanced vehicle technologies to further them along the path to full commercialization. Your participation provides customers with the cleanest personal mobility options when our state most needs them.

My staff has reviewed your vehicle eligibility application and has determined that the following GEM vehicles are eligible to receive the grant amounts listed in the table below when either purchased or leased for 36 months or longer on or after March 15, 2010.

| <b>GEM Model</b><br>(Model Years 2009/2010) | <b>Rebate</b><br>(\$) |

| e2  | 1,000                 |
| e4  | 1,300                 |
| eS  | 1,100                 |
| eL  | 1,300                 |
| eL XD                                       | 1,350                 |

Eligibility is on a first-come first-served basis contingent upon the availability of CVRP funding and provided that the vehicles meet the warranty requirements contained in the CVRP Implementation Manual (<http://www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/aqip/cvrp.htm>). The CVRP Manager at the California Center for Sustainable Energy will add these vehicle models to the vehicle eligibility list available from the CVRP website (<http://cvrp.energycenter.org>).
